We were advised on October 28, 2020, that a resident of The Mather Life Centre has a confirmed positive case of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The resident is receiving care within the Life Centre and is taking guidance from their physician. We wish this resident a full recovery.

We will continue testing employees and residents in the Life Centre twice a week until there are no new positive results.

All indoor visits in the Life Centre are suspended until we have no new COVID-19 cases for 14 consecutive days.

INDEPENDENT LIVING UPDATE: We have no new cases of COVID-19 in Independent Living.

INDOOR DINING PAUSED:

Suburban Cook County is experiencing an increase in Coronavirus positivity rates and in hospitalizations due to Coronavirus. Indoor dining in Evanston and surrounding suburbs was recently suspended by an order from Governor Pritzker, and The Mather is following suit. For now, we have **paused all restaurant service** in our community. We'll monitor local data and guidelines to determine when restaurants at The Mather may re-open.
