COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Employees of The Mather,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **one resident in Independent Living and two employees who work in Independent Living have tested positive for COVID-19. Note that this is our first time reporting these cases; these have not been reported in a previous letter.** We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

The Mather is interviewing each of these individuals to determine if he/she was in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

If you have cold-like symptoms, STAY HOME. <u>Do not come to work</u>, and notify HR immediately.

OUR COMMITMENT:

We're committed to keeping residents and staff healthy, and believe our collective efforts are the most effective way to minimize the number of cases. Each of you plays an essential role in keeping the virus out of our community. Please continue to live a low-risk lifestyle outside of work. Thank you for all you're doing to keep our community safe!

- 1. Practice **good hand hygiene** by washing your hands frequently for 20 or more seconds, or using hand sanitizer.
- 2. Practice **physical distancing** with others (no closer than 6 feet away for no more than 15 minutes).
- 3. Wear a good-quality face mask that covers your mouth and nose any time you are indoors in public. A surgical mask is recommended over cloth masks.
- 4. Avoid large gatherings.
