COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Employees of The Mather,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **two Independent Living residents have tested positive for COVID-19.** We wish these individuals a speedy recovery.

The Mather is interviewing the individuals to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

LAST DAY TO PREREGISTER - BOOSTER CLINIC APRIL 26:

Today is the last day you can preregister for the on-site clinic for second booster shots, which takes place Tuesday, April 26. While a second booster is completely voluntary, eligible employees can participate in the clinic. They must be age 50 or better or immunocompromised, and got their first booster at least four months ago.

Eligible employees should sign up through their HR Representative today. After you register, you will receive an appointment time along with a consent form, which you must complete ahead of time. **Please bring your vaccination card and a completed consent form to your appointment at the clinic.**

FEEL ILL? PLEASE STAY HOME:

Even if you are experiencing mild symptoms, like a cold or seasonal allergies, please err on the side of caution:

- Stay home. <u>Do not come to work.</u>
- **Take a COVID-19 test.** Please contact your personal physician if you have questions about at-home tests versus PCR testing. If you test positive, notify your personal physician immediately; there are new treatments they can prescribe that can decrease your risk of severe illness.
- If you test positive for COVID-19, notify HR immediately.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR MASK ON!

While we all continue to wear masks at work due to regulatory requirements, we ask that you consider wearing a well-fitting mask while indoors in any public area, based on CDC guidelines. This truly helps control the risk of spreading infection!
