COVID-19 UPDATE

Dear Residents of The Mather,

We wanted to inform you that we have learned that **an Independent Living resident has tested positive for COVID-19.** We wish this individual a speedy recovery.

The Mather is interviewing the individual to determine if they were in close contact with residents and/or employees (meaning within 6 feet of anyone for more than 15 minutes). Individuals who have been in close contact will be notified.

BOOSTER CLINIC APRIL 26:

The Mather is hosting an on-site clinic for second booster shots on Tuesday, April 26. Those age 50 and better can choose to get a second booster if it has been at least four months since their first booster. Interested residents must preregister for the clinic at the Concierge desk by Monday, April 18. After you register, you will receive an appointment time along with a consent form, which you must complete ahead of time.

Please bring your vaccination card, your insurance cards, and a completed consent form to your appointment at the clinic.

MASKS AT THE MATHER:

Face masks continue to be required in all indoor spaces in our community for residents, guests, and employees. This truly helps mitigate the risk of spreading infection! Thank you for wearing your mask and reminding your guests ahead of their visit.

We also encourage everyone to wear a well-fitting mask while indoors in any public area.

FEEL ILL? PLEASE STAY HOME:

Even if you are experiencing mild symptoms, like a cold or seasonal allergies, please err on the side of caution by

- staying in your home to avoid spreading a virus
- taking a COVID-19 test. Please contact your personal physician if you have questions about at-home tests versus PCR testing. If you test positive, notify your personal physician immediately; there are new treatments they can prescribe that can decrease your risk of severe illness.
